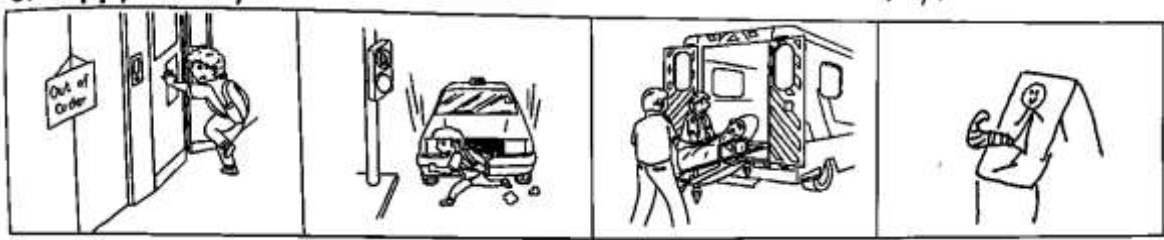


A Terrible Accident
